

WE EMPLOY A MANAGER, WHOSE ROLE IS TO RECRUIT & SUPPORT VOLUNTEERS, IDENTIFY LOCAL NEEDS AND ESTABLISH SCHEMES TO HELP MEET THESE NEEDS.

COMMUNITY SUPPORT CONTINUES TO GROW STEADILY EACH YEAR, BUT WITH THIS GROWTH COMES THE EXPECTED CHALLENGES OF ENSURING SUFFICIENT FUNDING IS SECURED TO SUSTAIN THESE DEMANDS.

# WHO WE ARE



The Board of Trustees has overall responsibility for Community Support and ensures that the organisation complies with required legislation. Trustees attend regular meetings and training events, as well as bringing forward ideas which enable us to meet the needs of our community. All BWCS trustees are volunteers based in the community, many with years of experience working locally or with Community Support. Staff are based in our Groe Street office, and are responsible for the day-to-day management of the organisation. Cathy Warlow, our manager, has been with us since the beginning.

Our team of volunteers provide all our services. Additionally, our team of office volunteers help out in our reception, answering phone calls, providing information and recording requests for our services. In 2022/23 we have a team of 30 volunteers.

# **COMMUNITY TRANSPORT**

Our volunteers use their own cars to provide transport for health care appointments. And some social This service is vital in a rural area like ours, offering a more affordable transport option for many. Passengers pay 30p/mile towards the cost of transport, with the remainder of the cost paid by BWCS funds



EVIE is our accessible electric MPV, funded by The National Lottery Community Fund Wales. You will see Evie out and about with our drivers and



our drivers and volunteers, taking you on days out with friends, to appointments, on shopping trips and delivering prescriptions.

# **PRESCRIPTION DELIVERY**

Prescriptions are collected and organised by staff members, before being delivered by our volunteer drivers.

Prescription Delivery is provided free of charge and funded entirely by donations.



BWCS is a satellite branch of Llandrindod Foodbank. We distribute food parcels to people in our membership area. Parcels can be collected in person or delivered. Anyone is welcome to come to the office and self refer.

Lunch Club is held twice a month. It provides a hot main course, dessert, tea and coffee for £5.

Membership is open to anyone over the age of 60 who lives in Builth, Llanelwedd, Cilmery, Aberedw, Builth Road, and Cwmbach. Occasionally we have guest speakers give presentations and speak to the diners.



# **SHOPPING DELIVERY**

This service offers members the ability to get their grocery shopping done. We take orders over the phone and by email, and send volunteers to local shops to collect the items and deliver them.

# **CHARITY SHOP**

Our shop was opened in May 2007 and continues to be a great success, thanks to the wonderful support from the community in donating and purchasing goods, and of course our fantastic Volunteers who staff the shop; sorting donations and serving customers with a smile on their faces and a cheery greeting to everyone.

The shop provides BWCS with an essential source of income as without this we would not be able to provide our services. It is also a valuable asset to our town, offering a variety of goods at reasonable prices and of course a great place to volunteer.

The shop currently has over 700 Gift Aid donors who bring items in for sale. With Gift Aid, we can claim an additional 25% on top of the sale price of each Gift Aid item.

# Builth and Llanwrtyd Wells Home Support



Home Support is an early intervention & prevention service funded by Powys County Council and delivered through BWCS, providing assistance to enable people to live at home, independently and safely.

Home Support services are FREE. You may self refer if you feel you will benefit from this service.


